

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RULES FOR THE DESIGN OF THE PRACTICE DIARY

A MANDATORY REPORT DOCUMENT ON THE STUDENT'S INTERNSHIP IS THE INTERNSHIP DIARY.

The internship diary should include protocols of various types of work (literary/methodological/experimental/analytical/other types of work) performed by the student during the practice.

Protocols are written for each day of work in practice. The protocol should contain information about the date, topic(s) of the lesson(s), the work performed during the individual task.

When logging work on the implementation of individual tasks (FROM), it is necessary to adhere to the following algorithm:

- 1. Describe the essence of the task (aims / tasks / algorithm / methodology, etc.)
- 2. Fix the actual data it is advisable to present it in a tabular format.
- 3. It is necessary to display personal participation in carrying out activities to fulfill the functional duties of a ward nurse, recording everything that he did, observed, and participated in (i.e., the types of work that are performed during working hours are indicated).
 - 4. Records should reflect the entire volume of work performed, be brief and clear.
- 5. It is necessary to make a brief conclusion /conclusions based on the results of the implementation of the individual task.

The internship diary must be signed:

- a) after each protocol by a nurse, under whose supervision he performed the work.
- b) on the title page the head of the practice from the organization (university) and the head of the practice from the profile organization (practice base)

INTRODUCTORY INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

The objectives of the internship are:

- to study of the functional responsibilities and working conditions of an operating nurse in surgical departments;
- to get practical skills in communicating with patients at the stage of preoperative preparation, interaction with medical personnel involved in the operational process, implementation of the principles of medical deontology;
- to get professional skills and developing professional skills of an operating nurse;
- to train in methods of maintaining a sanitary and hygienic environment in the operating unit;
- to get parctical skills in registration of the main types of medical documentation of the operating unit.

During the internship, the student must get skills (experience of activity):

- carrying out manipulations that ensure the maintenance of the sanitary and hygienic regime of the operating unit;
- carrying out manipulations that ensure the infectious safety of the patient and medical staff;
- carrying out manipulations that ensure the preparation of dressings;
- carrying out manipulations that ensure the preparation of surgical instruments;
- carrying out manipulations that ensure the disposal of disposable tools and materials used;
- carrying out manipulations that ensure the prevention of nosocomial infection;
- carrying out manipulations that ensure the hanwashing;
- wearing of medical overalls;
- laying the patient on the operating table.

At the end of the internship, the student should know:

- organization of surgical care in the Russian Federation;
- the structure and organization of the operation unit;
- the structure and organization of the dressing room;
- sanitary and hygienic requirements for the structural rooms of the operating unit;
- zones of the operating unit and their characteristics;
- functional responsibilities of an operating nurse;
- basic principles of medical ethics and deontology when working in the operating room;
- organization of the work of the surgical team;
- preoperative preparation of the patient in the operating room;
- features of the patient's location on the operating table, taking into account his anatomical and physiological characteristics;
- classic and modern handwashing methods;
- principles of processing the operating field according to Filonchikov-Grossich;
- purpose of surgical instruments, its main characteristics;
- appointment of suture and dressing materials, methods of their use in operative surgery;
- the basics of prevention and the main measures aimed at eliminating nosocomial infection;
- the concept of asepsis and antiseptics;
- methods and methods of sterilization of surgical instruments, dressings;
- methods of sterility control.

The student must be able to:

- to comply the rules of safety, sanitary and hygienic regulations
- to put on medical overall;

- handwashing with antiseptic solutions;
- to prepare the operating room and surgical team for the operation;
- to place the patient on the operating table, depending on the intended surgical access;
- to ensure the safety of the patient in the operating room;
- to prepare the operating field;
- to carry out cleaning in the operating unit, depending on the goal of achievement (preliminary, current, final, general) using modern disinfectants;
- prepare the dressing material;
- to put bandages, underwear, bathrobes, etc. in bixes;
- to carry out pre-sterilization preparation of surgical instruments;
- to dispose of used disposable tools and materials;
- to ensure the infectious safety of the patient and medical staff;
- to apply modern nursing technologies for prevention of nosocomial infection;
- to interact with members of the treatment team, maintain the psychological climate in the department, and adhere to the principles of ethics.
