

## **List of requirements for providing independent work for students at the department for operative surgery and topographic anatomy.**

Student independent (individual) work (here in after referred to as SIW) is included in the work program of each discipline taught at the department for operative surgery and topographic anatomy. In order to monitor students' performance of independent work and recording, the Electronic Information and Educational Portal (hereinafter referred to as EIEP) is used.

In the specialized section of the EIEP, the student publishes the completed SIW during the semester (before the deadline for graduation in the discipline). Completing the SIW in accordance with the work programs of the disciplines is possible in the format of an abstract. The abstract forms that can be taken into account as an SIW are as follows:

- abstract in printed form;
- abstract in written form, including in the form of a supporting abstract (thesis summary);
- abstract in the form of a presentation.

The student presents his work on the EIEP in the appropriate section. As the check progresses, the teacher evaluates the work before issuing the resulting rating in the relevant discipline, which is recorded on the EIEP and in the journal of current progress. The SIW grade is taken into account when calculating the final rating of the corresponding discipline.
