

I Cardiovascular System

HYPERTENSION (HTN)

- At first establish diagnosis of hypertension by measuring blood pressure (BP).
- Then clarify whether it is essential HTN or secondary HTN (NB. For patients <40 years, consider specialist referral to exclude secondary causes.)

1. If Essential HTN, then

- Stage hypertension as per classification.

Normal	< 120 and < 80 mmHg
Stage I	140–159 and/or 90–99 mmHg
Stage II	≥ 160 and/or ≥ 100 mmHg
Severe HTN	≥ 180 and/or ≥ 110 mmHg
- Ascertain the need for drug treatment.

Indications of drug therapy:

- 1 Stage I and Stage II HTN

Dx:

Cardiac (central) chest pain on exertion, relieved by rest or nitrate (retrosternal choking or constricting chest pain, comes on with exertion, relieved by rest or nitroglycerin, may radiate to jaw, neck or arms (more in left arm)).

Key Investigations:

- ECG: The resting 12 lead ECG may be normal in 70 percent of patients; symmetrical T wave inversion is suggestive of coronary ischaemia (Fig. 1.1)
- If resting ECG is normal
- CAG, blood sugar and lipid profile


