Ongoing performance monitoring: assessment of competency development is carried out during students' contact with instructors during their internship based on interviews on test questions, demonstrations of practical skills (abilities), and review and submission of their internship diary.

Midterm assessment is conducted in the form of a graded test. Midterm assessment for internship includes the following types of assignments: interviews on test questions, assessment of practical skills acquisition, and report preparation (which involves defending the internship diary and reporting on the completion of individual assignments).

Questions for assessing the acquisition of practical skills:

(verified indicators of competency achievement: OPC-1.3.1; OPC-10.2.1; PC-6.1.1)

1. Manipulations ensuring the maintenance of personal hygiene of seriously ill patients (assistance with morning toilet, creating a comfortable position for the patient).
2. Manipulations ensuring the maintenance of personal hygiene of seriously ill patients (toilet of the skin, oral cavity, ears).
3. Manipulations ensuring the maintenance of personal hygiene of seriously ill patients (washing hair).
4. Manipulations ensuring the maintenance of personal hygiene of seriously ill patients (delivering a bedpan, urine bag).
5. Manipulations ensuring the maintenance of personal hygiene of seriously ill patients (toilet of the external genitalia).
6. Manipulations ensuring the maintenance of personal hygiene of seriously ill patients (skin care, prevention of bedsore).
7. Measuring the patient's body temperature (graphic recording in the temperature chart) sheet).
8. Feeding a seriously ill patient.
9. Counting respiratory movements.
10. Blood pressure measurement.
11. Determination and counting of the pulse on the radial artery.

12. Preparing the patient for ultrasound of the abdominal organs, retroperitoneal space, and bladder.
13. Preparing the patient for FGDS, radiography of the stomach.
14. Preparing the patient for colonoscopy, irrigography.
15. Carrying out a cleansing enema.
16. Shaving the surgical field.
17. Placement of a nasogastric tube.
18. Bladder catheterization.
19. Transporting the patient from the ward to the operating room.
20. Placement on the operating table, removal from the table.
21. Installation of the gas outlet tube.
22. Filling and serving an ice pack.
23. Monitoring and maintenance of drains and drainage systems.
24. Observation and care Stoma.
25. Changing underwear and bed linen for a patient with limited mobility.
26. Providing first aid for heart pain.
27. Providing first aid for a hypertensive crisis.
28. Providing first aid for fainting and collapse.
29. Providing first aid for hemoptysis and pulmonary hemorrhage.
30. Providing first aid for sudden shortness of breath (asphyxiation).
31. Providing first aid for vomiting.
32. Providing first aid for external bleeding.
33. Providing first aid for renal colic.
34. Performing resuscitation measures (artificial ventilation).
35. Performing resuscitation measures (closed cardiac massage).
