1.	Diagnostics and differential diagnostics, using innovative methods ¹ . Methods of assessing the readiness of the pregnant woman's body for childbirth. Monitoring of fetal health during pregnancy and childbirth. Methods of correction of isthmic-cervical insufficiency. Methods of preparation of the cervix for childbirth and labor excitation. Perform an internal obstetric examination and assess the condition of the birth canal on the phantom. Perform an amniotomy. Provide manual assistance for head presentation on a phantom.
